The Mendocino Art Center does not have storage facilities and your artwork is insured only for the duration of the exhibit. If you are unable to pick up your work, please provide prior written authorization for another person to do so on your behalf. For more information, contact our Exhibitions Manager.

ELIGIBILITY / FEES / SALES

This show is open to all current MAC Members. One to three pieces of original work in any medium may be submitted. Please submit artwork which has not previously shown at MAC. Each piece must not exceed 50 pounds or 40 inches wide. Work must be received ready to install with proper hanging devices attached. (No saw tooth hangers please). Please label each piece of work with the artist's name, telephone number, email address, title of work, medium, and retail price of work. Artwork should be photographed before submission.

A non-refundable entry fee of \$15 per piece will be charged. All work must be for sale. You will receive 60% of the sales price. MAC retains a 40% commission on all sales for the purpose of sustaining our exhibit and education programs.
