**THREE-COLOR POURS IN WATERCOLOR**

**Materials List:**

- Three TUBES of colors transparent watercolor paint 15ml. Choose a yellow, red, and blue from the list below. You may bring other colors that you would like to experiment with if there is time.
  - Choice of red: Windsor Red, Permanent Magenta, Alizarin Crimson, Carmine, Permanent Rose
  - Choice of Blue: Windsor Blue, Pthalo Blue, (\*Ultramarine Blue)
  - Choice of Yellow: Gamboge, Windsor Yellow Quinacrodone Gold
- Paint brushes—bring what you have, include a lifting brush.
- Your palette and additional mixing containers/wells
- 300Lb Watercolor paper-2 sheets (Suggest Fabriano or Saunders Waterford i/o Arches)
- Gator board or equivalent to tape paper to (16x23 nice size for half sheet of watercolor and easy to handle)
- Masking fluid- Recommend Pebeo
- Finesline Masking Fluid Pen (Supernib-Fine tip)
- Brush for applying masking fluid
- Clear plastic shower curtain or other plastic to cover table
- Pencil & Kneaded Eraser
- Sketch pad
- Paper towels- Viva
- 2-water containers,
- Shop Rags
- Apron
- Masking tape (2" wide)
- Several photo references with stark value contrasts of light and shadow
- \* Bring if you have: a Large plastic “under bed storage” bin or equivalent. \*
