Materials List:

This workshop will not cover techniques related to a variety of materials, but will concentrate on observing and rendering the human figure. For this purpose, only the following materials are required:

- 24-50 sheet pad of newsprint, "sketch," or "drawing" paper, 14" x 17" or 18" x 24".
- A charcoal pencil, any hardness from 2B to 6B. **OR** A "Woodless graphite" pencil, hardness 4B to 8B.
- A pastel chalk pencil (such as General's), sanguine or other red.
- Alphacolor "Char-Kole" stick.

All of these materials are available either at Harvest/Mendoza's Market in Mendocino, or Racine's Art and Office Supplies in Fort Bragg, or are obtainable at some supplier like Blick Art Materials in an urban area. The Alphacolor "Char-Kole" stick will also be available to purchase at the workshop.
